Show and Tell

This is a 3 minute speech. You will have the option of an informative or demonstrative speech. You may not talk about something that is illegal or not allowed at school. You must have your topic approved and reserved by Ms. Zinn. The two speech formats are:

1. An informative speech: You will tell the class about three items that are special to you. You will bring the items or a representation of the item(s) to class. You will describe each object, tell how you received it, and why it is special to you.
2. A demonstration speech: You will teach the class how to do something. Include a list of materials needed, step-by-step instructions, the results, variations and the clean up process. Anything that requires special permission (certain food items, things involving animals etc.) will need to be pre-approved before you work on your speech.

Whether you choose the information or demonstration format, ALL students must use some kind of visual aid during the speech.

You will complete a series of brainstorming and planning worksheets for this project as well as an outline that you may use when you present your speech.

You need to speak for at least three minutes during your speech.
