

Source Guidelines for Extemp Speech

Must have at least 6 different articles from 6 different sources.

Extemp articles must be printed with the following criteria:

Read or at least skim the article before printing. Do not print articles that are not useful to you. If you print it, you better use it as a source in your speech.

Use the “Print” feature found within most articles.

Use the “Print Preview” feature and print only the pages necessary.

Printing should be limited to no more than 3 pages per article unless prior permission is granted.

Articles must be printed from the original source NOT copy and pasted.

Articles must have the source information: Title of Source (Newsweek) and Date of article.

Avoid printing pictures if possible.

Blogs or author commentary with comments are not acceptable.

Wikipedia should not be used as a source of information.

You may highlight articles, but in ONE color only.

You may not write on your articles at ALL.
